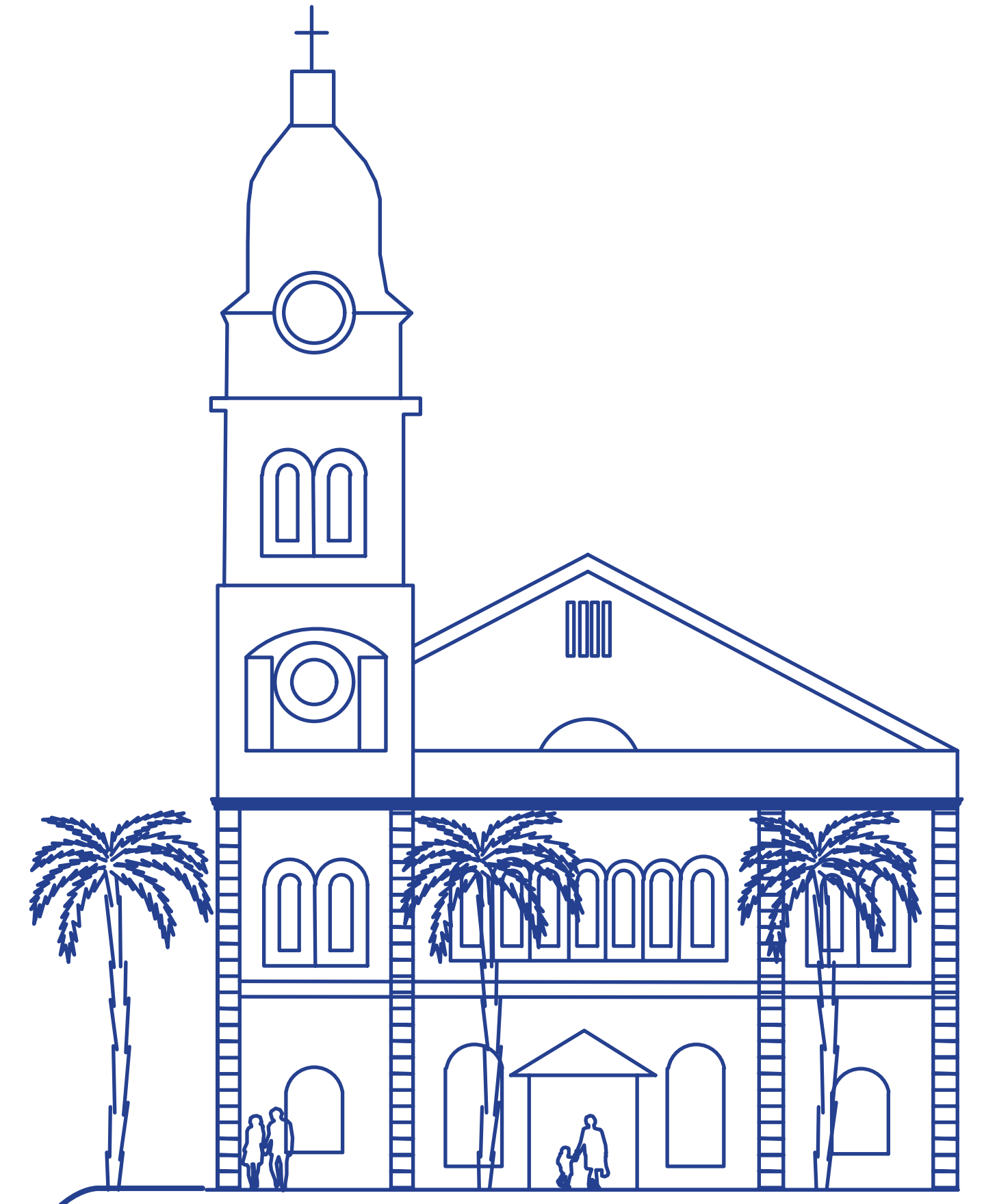

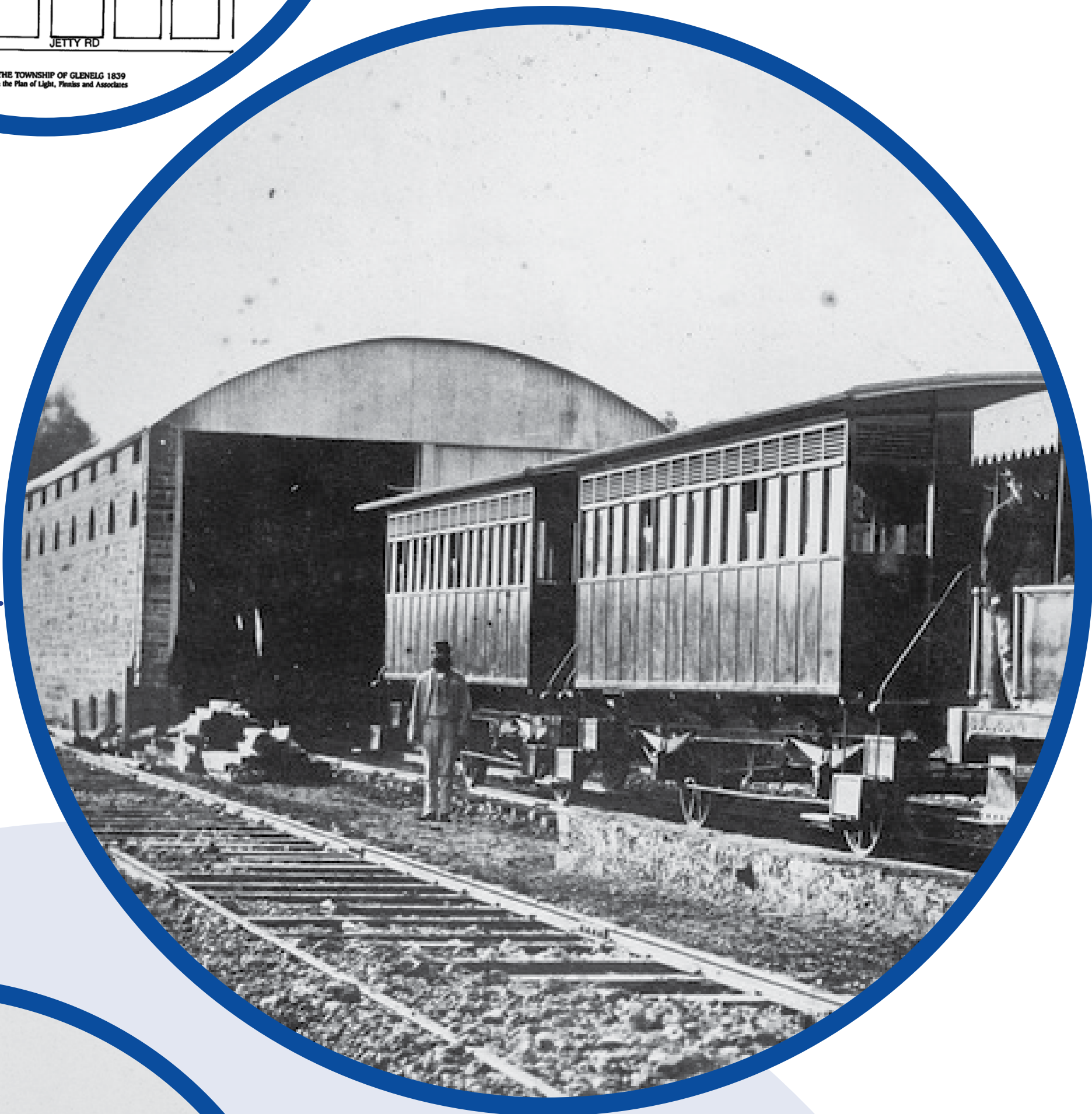

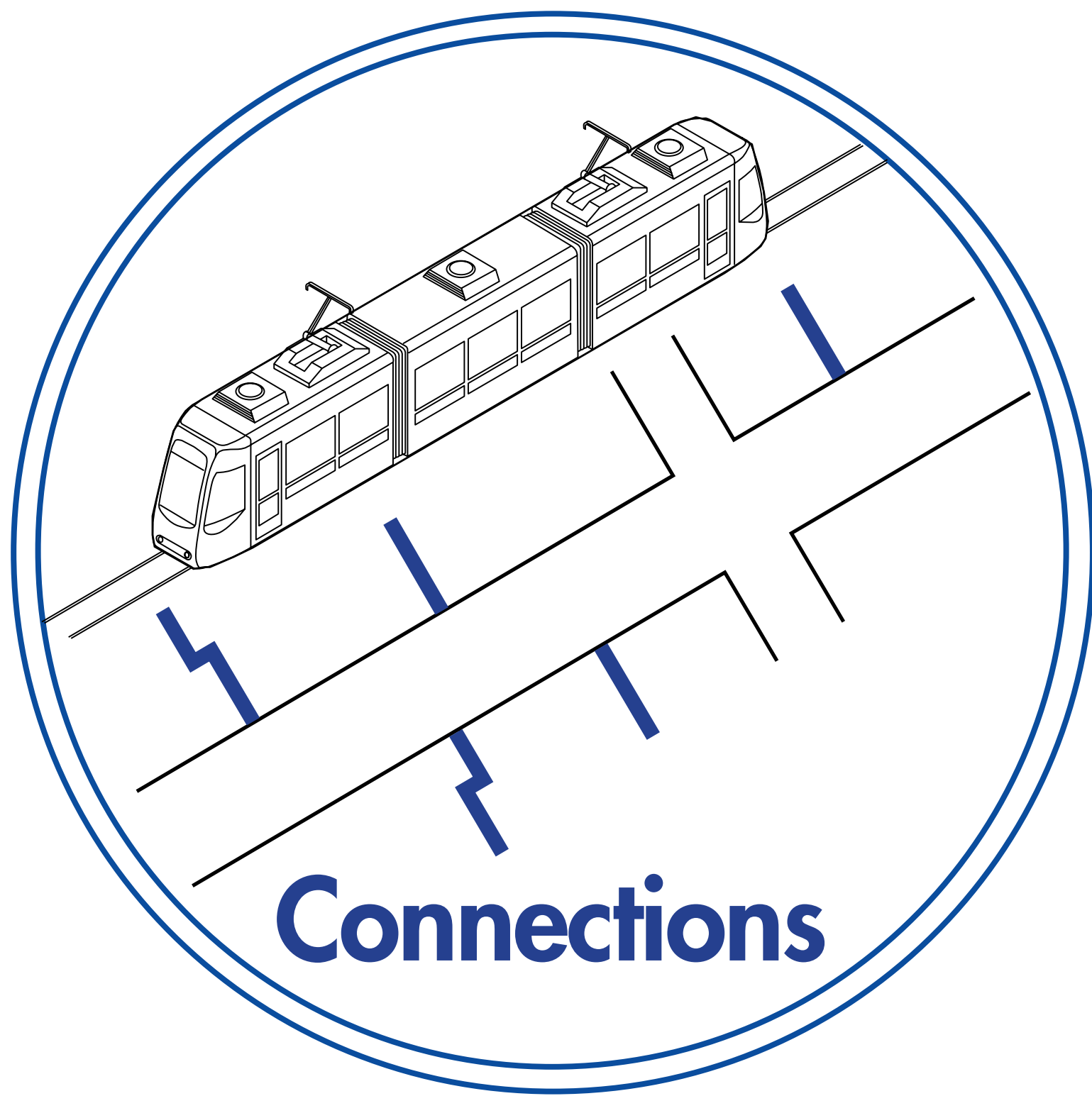

Public Engagement Steps

Planning alone will not make Jetty Road 'sing'. A commitment to community involvement and response will allow Jetty Road to become an even more active place of meaning and connection that contributes towards the cultural environment and economic life of Glenelg and to metropolitan Adelaide.

The Jetty Road Glenelg Masterplan aims to engage with all users that interact with Jetty Road. There is a high level of community consultation and engagement involved in creating a new plan for Jetty Road. Our engagement has been broken down into three keys steps, where you can become part of the planning process and shape your views on how Jetty Road should be transformed.

Phase 1 - Early 2017 Initial Engagement

Outcomes:

- › Gain shared understanding of the Precinct's identity and appeal from different user groups (business owners/traders/residents/visitors).
- › Capture the Community's future aspirations for Jetty Road Glenelg.
- › Identify strengths and weaknesses of Jetty Road.
- › Establish a common vision for the Jetty Road Glenelg Masterplan.

Phase 2 - Mid 2017 Engagement on Draft Concepts

Outcomes:

- › Investigate specific opportunities and issues in greater detail.
- › Identify key priority areas.
- › Develop a draft vision and concepts for Jetty Road, taking into consideration first stage of consultation.
- › Gain further input from key stakeholders, traders and businesses on 'the vision' for Jetty Road.
- › Test the draft vision and concepts with the Community and refine them accordingly.

Phase 3 - Late 2017 Engagement on Draft Masterplan

Outcomes:

- › Outline preferred vision and design direction for Jetty Road Glenelg.
- › Present an implementation strategy for Jetty Road, which includes priority areas and long term implementation recommendations.
- › Present draft Masterplan to the Community and stakeholders for comment.
- › Develop final Masterplan based on Community feedback.
