





Benefits

- Multi-user space

Issues

- Pedestrian safety and poor sidewalk environment
- Footpath congestion .
- Cycle safety
- Vehicle dominance
- Congestion along Jetty Road due to on-street parking.
- Lack of space for additional tree planting & outdoor dining

- Improved pedestrianised environment

- Removal of vehicle corridor

- Significant length to function as a mall


Benefits

Street Composition




If we have all this we need 27.8m








Chapel Street - Event Mode
